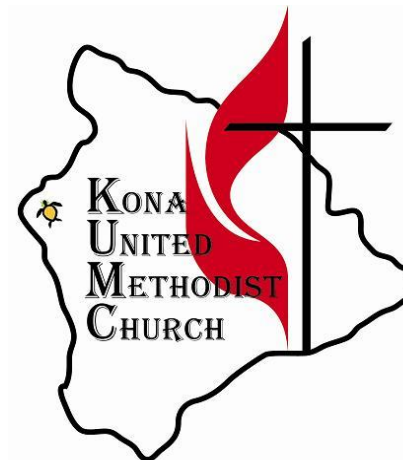
2019 Holy Land Trip & Egypt (16-Day, 03/12-27, 2019): Please speak to Pastor Sunny if you would like to join the trip.
