SUMMER FREE Meals for the School-Age Children through July 17 offered by the Hawaii State Department of Education: *Breakfast* will be available from 7:30am-8am, and ***lunch*** will be offered from 11:30am-12noon. The “grab-and-go” meal pick up sites are: *Hilo Union School (lunch only), Honoka’a High & Inter, Kalaniana’ole Elementary & Inter, Kea’au High, Kealakehe High (lunch only), Keonepoko Elementary, Kohala High School, Mt. View Elementary, Na’alehu Elementary, Pahoa High & Inter, Waiakea High, Waikoloa Elementary & Middle (lunch only), Waimea Elementary.* Meals will be located outside of the cafeteria.

FREE Food Distribution: The Hawaii Food Basket is a partner organization with Kona UMC. They are distributing free food for anyone in need. Supplies are limited and will be distributed on a first come first served basis. The list of distribution sites and date/time can be found at www.HawaiiFoodBasket.org. 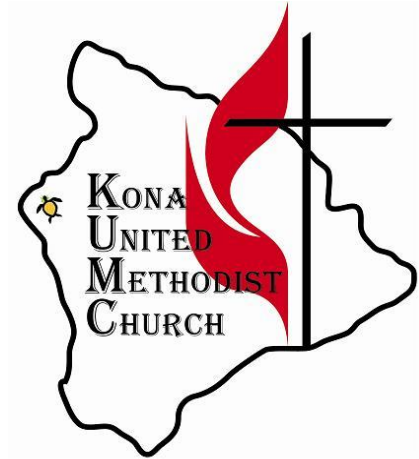
