

**WHAT TO EXPECT**  
**for the 8:30am In-Person, “Drive-In” Worship Service**  
**that will take place starting Sunday, November 1<sup>st</sup>**  
(as of 10-31-2020)

As you enter the church property, ushers will direct you to pre-marked, physically distanced parking spaces in the front and/or back parking lots. Due to the spacing for the vehicles in the parking lot, we will not be able to allow attendees to sit outside their vehicles in the parking lot.

Attendees with a pick up may sit in the back of the pick up which will offer the safety protection from any cars pulling into and out of the parking spaces and provide safe distancing within the confines of the vehicle.

If you choose to remain in your vehicle, you may join the Worship Service through **Radio Frequency 1650 AM** in the church parking lot OR via **ZOOM-Live** with **both video and audio [Meeting ID: 868 6074 9246; Password: KUMC]** Or **audio only [call 669-900-9218 with Meeting ID: 868 6074 9246; Passcode: 514383]**.

Upon entering the church parking lot and joining via ZOOM, everyone will be muted and all videos will be disabled, except the church worship service audio and video. Based on the Internet connection stability and the physical worship service environment, there is no guarantee of the quality of the worship experience via ZOOM. But, please know that we are trying.

**Requirements for in-person worship in the sanctuary include:** wearing a face mask at all times and bringing your own chair.

Before you enter the sanctuary, you must stop by the Greeter Table to have your temperature checked with a non-touch thermometer, sanitize your hands with the sanitizer provided on the table, and complete a Registration Card with your name, contact information, and signature.

Ushers will then direct you to pre-marked physically distanced spaces in the sanctuary in which to place your chair. Family members may sit together.

The restrooms will be available, but we encourage you to use them **ONLY** when you must use them. Only one person at a time can use the restroom.

The water fountain has been disconnected. So, bring your own drinks to quench your thirst while you are at church.

**Just a gentle reminder:** No singing for everyone, except the ones in the vehicle and the song leader (vocal) in church to lead the worship music. No hugging, no shaking hands, and no food or fellowship before or after the Worship Service.

No printed worship bulletin will be provided. So, please print your own bulletin at home or download the worship bulletin from our church website (KonaUMC.com) to your phone or tablet/iPad prior to attending the service.

There are many protections in place for your health and safety. Our priority is the safety of all worshipers and disciples of Jesus Christ at Kona United Methodist Church.

We are grateful to be making progress by being able to gather again in-person, and yet creatively in the form of “Drive-In” worship service at this time. So thanks be to God! Please know that we’re exploring many different options to accommodate all expressed needs. So, we ask for your patience during this time of transition.
