Lent 2023 @ Kona UMC (2/22-4/6): Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. Lent is influenced by the 40 days Jesus spent in the wilderness prior to beginning His ministry. For this season, we desire to emerge from our personal wilderness prepared to make disciples.

Ash Wednesday (2/22, @ 7pm): Ash Wednesday Service at Kona UMC is a Taize Service including the traditional imposition of ashes. This service is a hybrid service that can be joined In-Person or via Facebook Live. A prefilled "ash" cup for the self-imposition of ashes will be provided. Please contact the Church Office if you would like to have one to participate in the service via Facebook Live.

Joint HUI Lenten Study 2023 via Zoom (6 weeks, starting Monday, 2/27, 7pm): This study is organized by four churches on the Big Island of Hawaii—Hilo UMC, Honokaa UMC, Naalehu UMC, and Kona UMC. 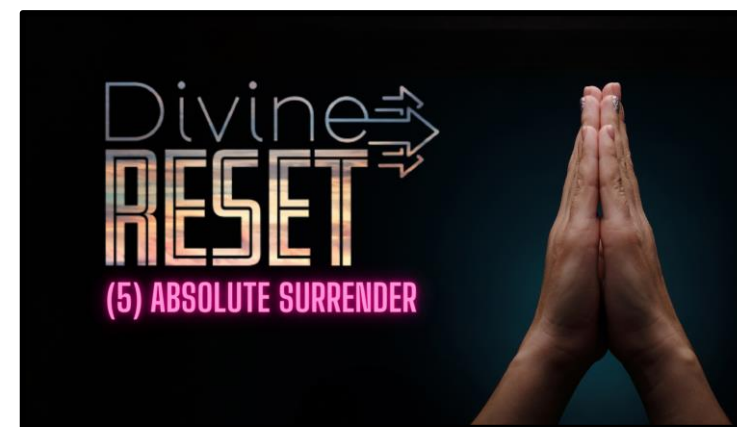
