Palm Sunday (3/24, 8:30am, Hybrid Worship): Palm Sunday is the day we remember the “triumphal entry” of Jesus into Jerusalem exactly one week before His resurrection (Easter, Matthew 21:1-11).

Maundy Thursday (3/28, 7pm, Hybrid Worship): Maundy Thursday is the day to commemorate the Washing of the Feet and the Last Supper of Jesus Christ with His Disciples. Instead of the feet-washing, Kona UMC’s Maundy Thursday service features the Lord’s Supper with Hand Washing.

Good Friday (3/29, 7pm, Hybrid Worship): Good Friday is the day commemorating the crucifixion of Jesus and His death at Calvary. Kona UMC’s Good Friday Service is a Tenebrae Service (Service of Shadows), recreating the emotional aspects of the passion story with the stripping of the sanctuary to dramatize the desolation, abandonment, and darkness of the passion and death of our Lord. The service ends in darkness and silence.

Holy Saturday (3/30, 5pm): The Stations of the Cross is a devotional mini pilgrimage. We will meet at Grace Community Church at 5pm.

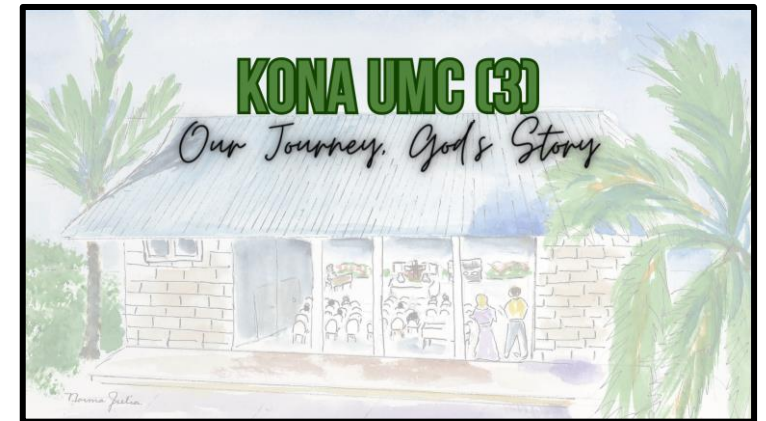
