Maundy Thursday (3/28, 7pm, Hybrid Worship): Maundy Thursday is the day to commemorate the Washing of the Feet and the Last Supper of Jesus Christ with His Disciples. Instead of the feet-washing, Kona UMC's Maundy Thursday service features the Lord's Supper with Hand Washing.

Good Friday (3/29, 7pm, Hybrid Worship): Good Friday is the day commemorating the crucifixion of Jesus and His death at Calvary. 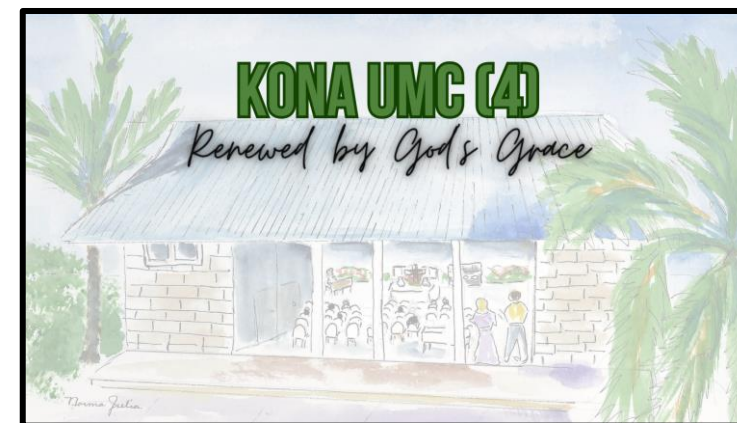
